| <b>KRALJEVA SUTJESKA</b> | <b>Mehmeda el-Fatih's mosque</b><br> | <b>III sacral</b>        | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>According to popular belief this is the oldest mosque in BiH. However, this has not been proven by historical evidence. Allegedly, the mosque was built by the sultan Muhamed II el-Fatih after his army conquered Bobovac, the capital of the Bosnian kingdom. The mosque has undergone extensive alterations. | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>FBiH government initiated in 2006 activities to restore the mosque. The restoration is planned to proceed in several phases.  |
|                          | <i>Incunabulae</i>  | <b>National treasure</b> | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>-   | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br><i>Incunabulae</i> , books printed prior to 1500, are of particular importance and value. The monastery in Kraljeva Sutjeska keeps 31 <i>incunabulae</i> , half of the total number of <i>incunabulae</i> in BiH. |
| <b>DRAČIĆI</b>           | <b>Mill at Dubočica</b>   | <b>III ethnographic</b>  | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>There is an old mill at Dubočica creek. It is owned by Savo Cvijetić and it is still in function.   | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The mill is destroyed.  |
| <b>GORA JANJIČKA</b>     | <b>Mosque</b>   | <b>III sacral</b>        | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The present day mosque was built in 1870s. There was previously a smaller mosque standing in this place.  | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>We found the object described by professor Kreševljaković. There is a plate with two reconstruction years (1959 and 1982). The mosque has been significantly altered.   |

There is also an orthodox cemetery but it holds no significant monuments.</p>   | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>The church is located above the regional road Sarajevo-Zenica. It was restored in 1996/97. The church is on the temporary list of national monuments.</p> |
| <b>DESETNIK</b>  | <b>Teferič</b>   | <b>ethnographic</b>      | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>Teferič (fair) is held on 4<sup>th</sup> August each year at the site called Vrutci. It has been held for more than 100 years.</p>                        | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>The fair is still organized every year, although with smaller number of participants.</p>   |
| <b>LIPNICA</b>   | <p><b>Two mills on Lazina</b></p>  | <b>III ethnographic</b>  | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>There used to be 11 mills on Lazina creek. Only two of those remain today. One of these is very old and maximum effort should be made to preserve it.</p> | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>There are no mills remaining on Lazina. There is only an old one, but we were unable to find out whose property it was.</p>                               |
| <b>IVNICA</b>    | <b>Mills</b>   | <b>III ethnographic</b>  | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>4 mills remain in Ivnica. Two of them are still in function.</p>  | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>No mills remain in Ivnica.</p>  |

| <b>BRNJIC</b>   | <b>Mill</b>                      | <b>III ethnographic</b>   | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>There used to be over 20 mills at Tisovac creek. Only one remains today, so effort should be made to preserve it.                               | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>No mills remaining.     |
|                 | <b>House of Munira Škulj</b>     | <b>III housing object</b> | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>This is a typical example of a two-story rural house, result of inventiveness of rural craftsmen in solving key problems of house construction. | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The house is destroyed. |

| <b>SOPOTNICA</b> | <p><b>Mills</b></p>   | <b>III<br/>ethnographic</b> | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>There used to be numerous mills on Sopotnica river with the surrounding villages bringing their wheat to be milled in Sopotnica mills.</p> | <p><b>Description and state of object:</b><br/>We found 5 of 7 mills registered by professor Kreševljaković. Two of them have been significantly altered.</p> |

The house is still functional, although slightly altered. | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The object was destroyed by a landslide.     |

It is almost 200 years old. It was used as court house, while the cellar was used as prison.  | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The building as well as the entire settlement is planned for demolition.  |
| <b>DONJI KAKANJ</b> | <b>Han</b>  | <b>II utilitarian</b>    | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br><i>Han</i> (resting places) have become very rare in BiH. Donji Kakanj used to be an important centre and the building of Požarev han is at least 200 years old. It was closed just before WWI. It is now used as a cow-shed. | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>Han was demolished in 2006 and a housing object was erected in its place. |
|                     | <b>Mill</b>   | <b>III ethnographic</b>  | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The mill is owned by Zahid Alajbegović. There used to be 11 mills in Donji Kakanj, but only one has remained in function to this day.   | <b>Description and state of object:</b><br>The mill is destroyed.  |
